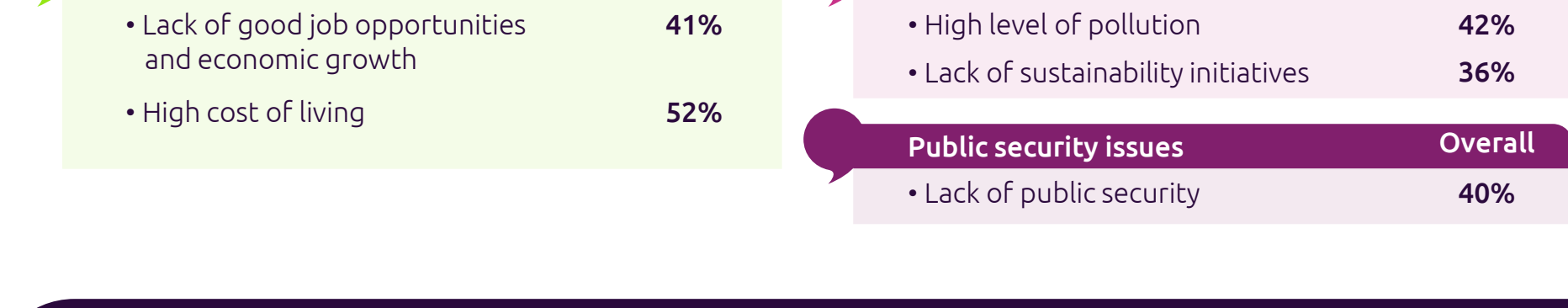

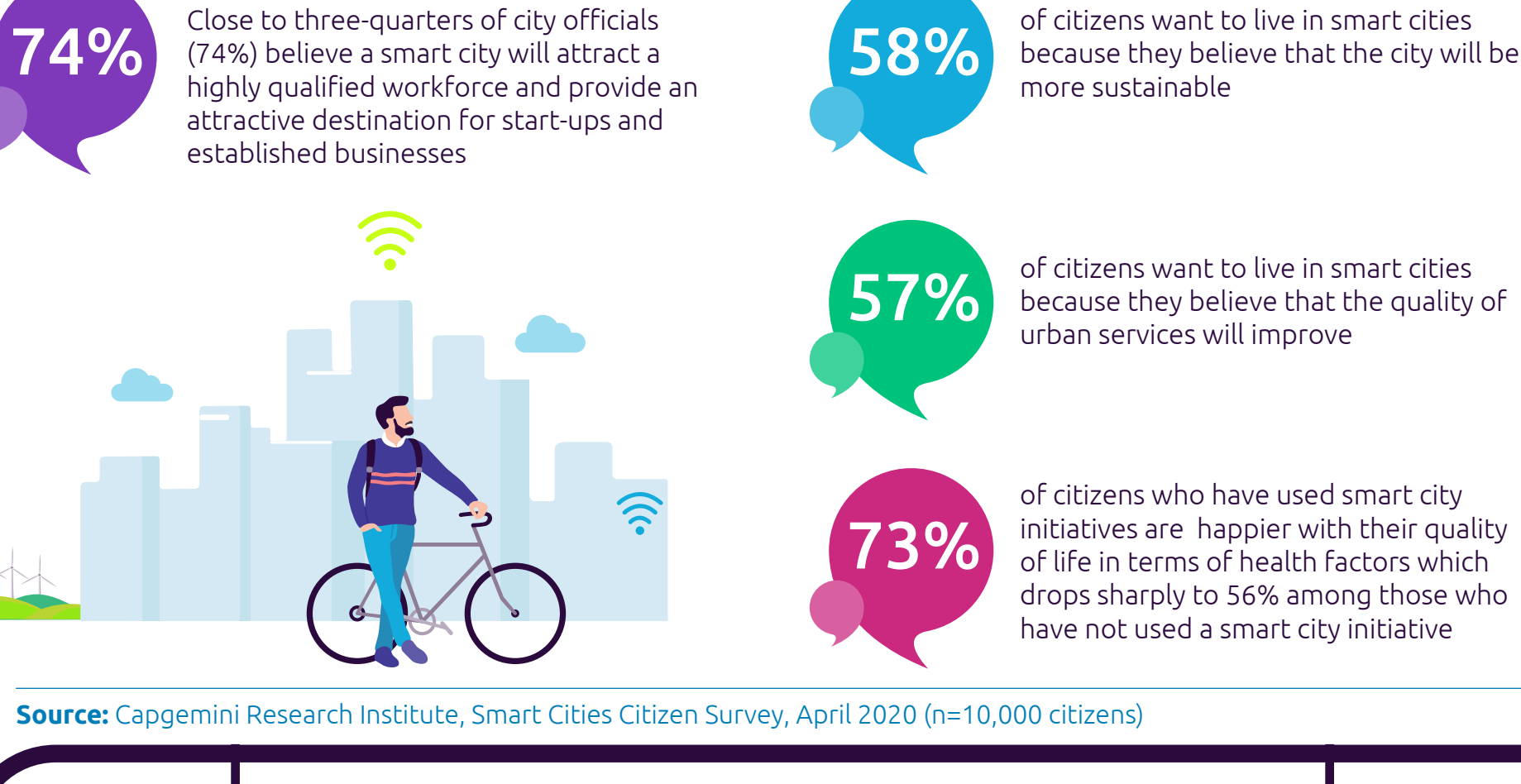


Biggest Challenge that can lead to citizens to leaving a city - by city

Why do smart cities hold the key to improving urban life?



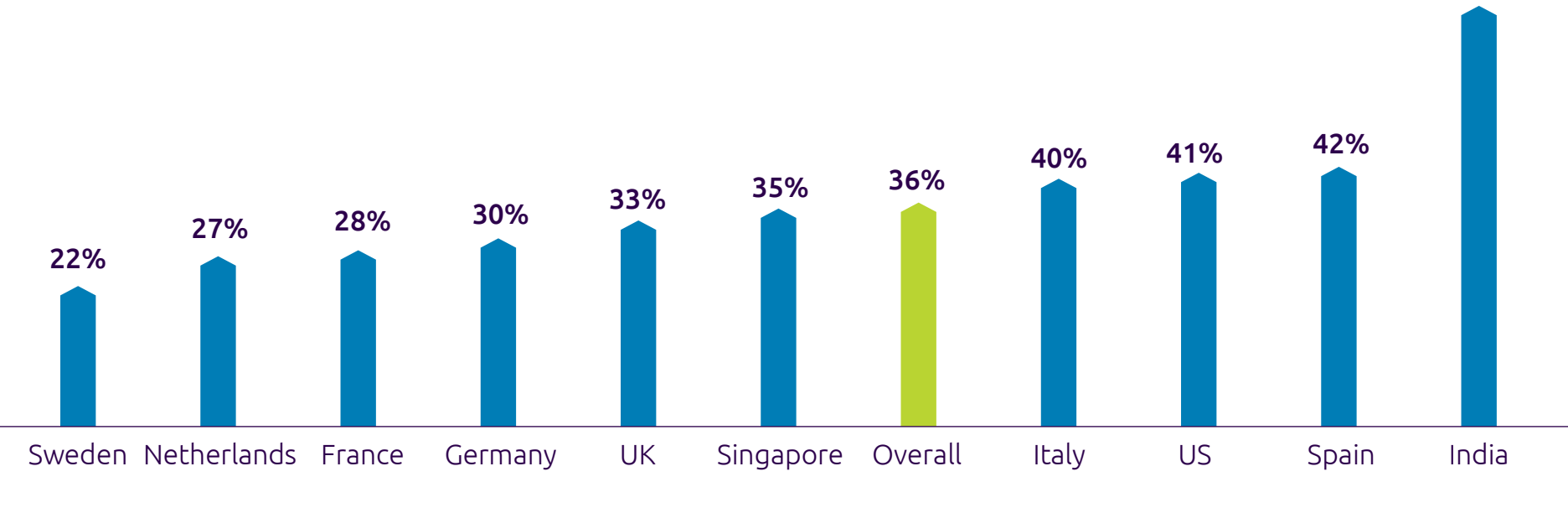

Citizens want a better urban existence and are prepared to pay more for using smart city initiatives

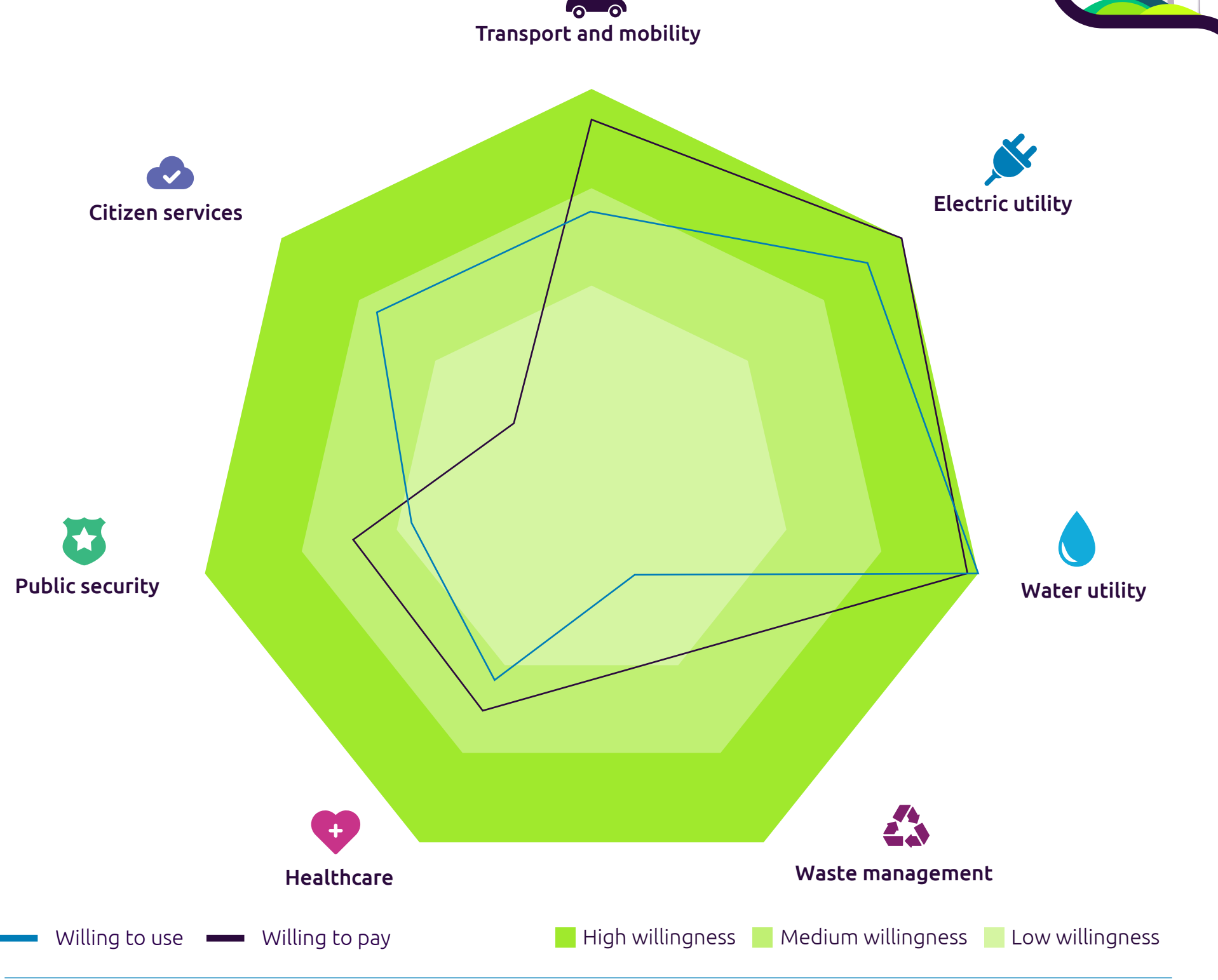
Millennials and Indian citizens are willing to pay more for smart city initiatives

Over a third (36%) of citizens are willing to pay more for using smart city initiatives. This figure is higher for Millennials (44%), Gen Z (41%)

I would be willing to pay more to access smart city initiatives because I want to live in a highly developed and connected city

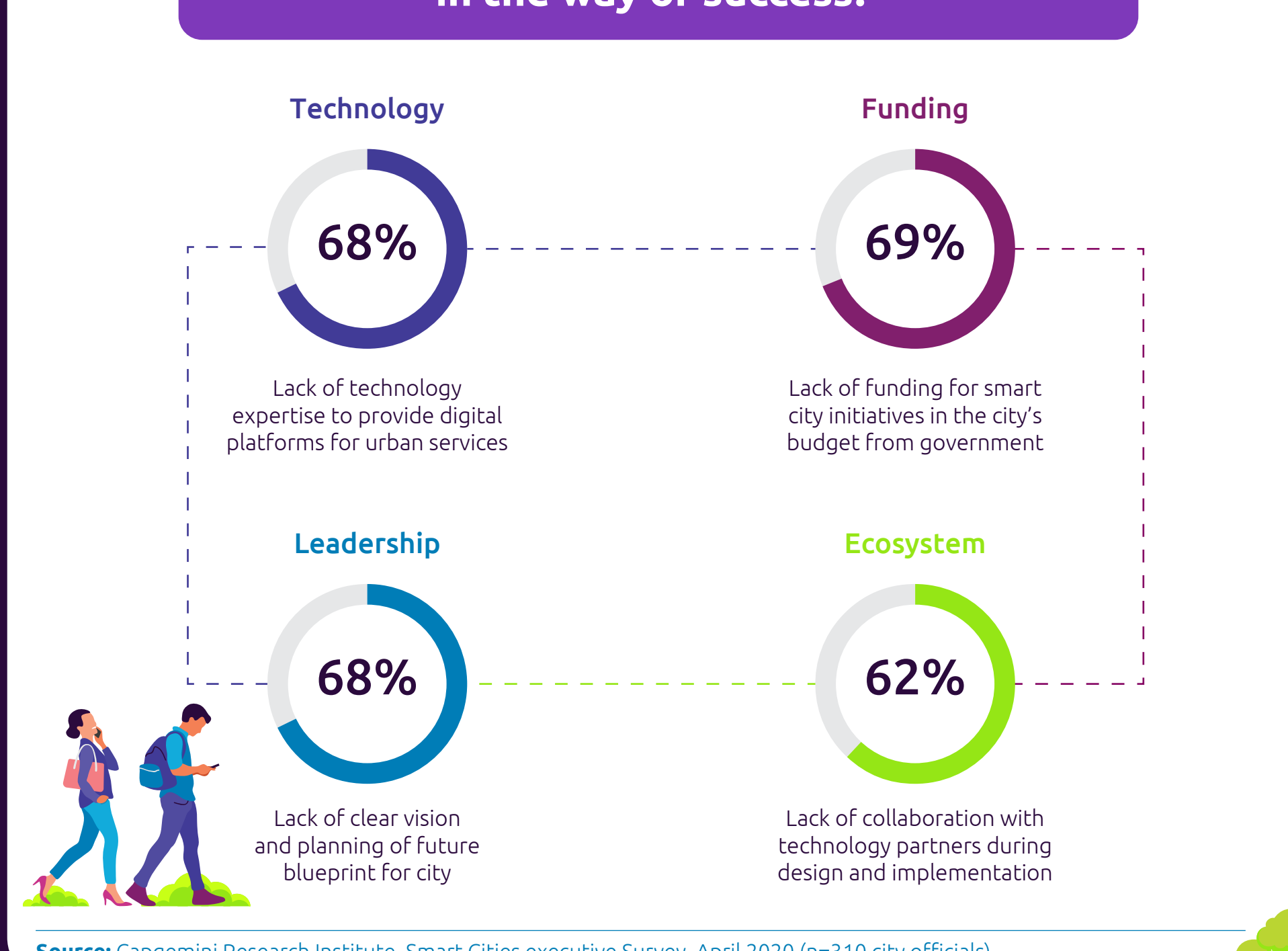


High level of citizen interest in smart city initiatives



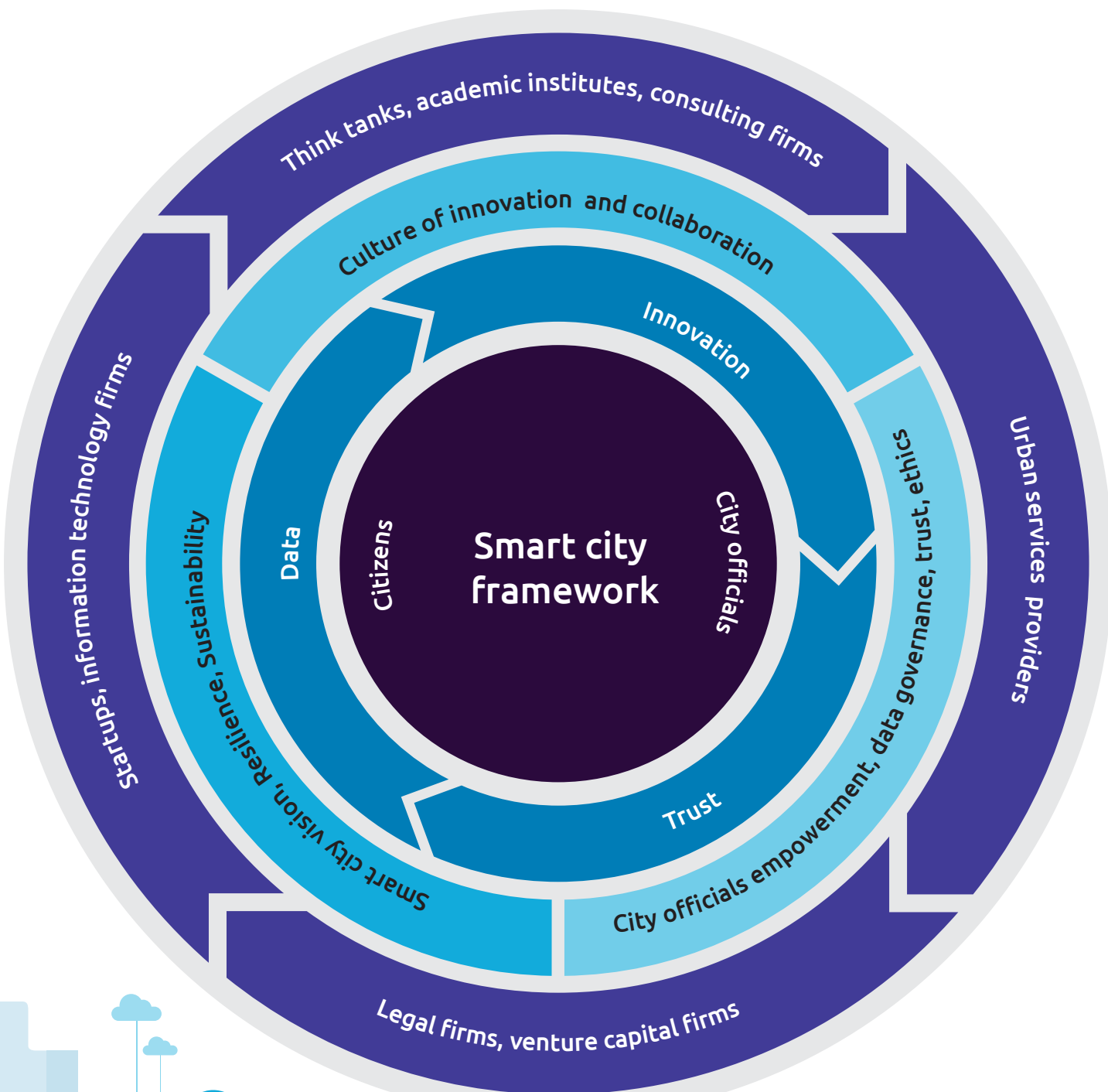
